

Registration as an NHS patient

To register please bring your registration forms and the following original documents:

- Photo ID (passport/Driving License)
- Proof of address (Registration for council tax/ tenancy agreement, utility bill, bank statement)
- For children we will only need identification such as passport or birth certificate
- Documents dated 6-12months showing UK residence.

If you cannot show that you have lived in the UK for the last 6 months, please provide the following information and leave your application with us so we can check your eligibility. This applies to all applicants including EU/EEA nationals and returning UK nationals)

What is the purpose of your visit to the UK?

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Can you prove you have the right to remain in the UK?

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Examples of acceptable proof that you will be resident in the UK for more than 6months:

- Employment contract (married couple one is sufficient + marriage certificate)
- Letter from a college stating they are on a course for the required period
- Home Office documentation confirming right to be in the country
- Nationals of A8 countries should show Accession State Worker Registration card

**If you are on repeat medications please
have a month's supply before registering!**
